THE MAGELLAN 160

Chief Designer Mark Fitzgerald has configured the MAGELLAN series as the culmination of the Paine office's long career designing some of the most luxurious and fuel efficient custom motor yachts ever built. The Magellan 160 hull is designed for steel construction with an aluminium superstructure. Her strong continuous sheerline is emphasized by its massive, beautifully varnished teak cap. The owners' suite will be forward, and lit by an atrium that extends upwards to the Portuguese bridge cowl. Amidships beneath the buttress arch will be a swimming pool - the center of family entertainment on sunny days. A pushbutton actuated canopy will cover this area when rain or too much sun is encountered, and will offer an upper deck for lounging when deployed.

The Magellan 160 offers the following features, which simply have never been combined elsewhere on a single yacht.

- 1. Moderate displacement with a D/L of 225.
- 2. Partially chined, multi spray-straked hull to minimize roll.
- 3. Unique, deployable upper deck.
- 4. Dining area aft on main deck.
- 5. Pilothouse offers full 360 degree views.
- 6. Portuguese bridge forward of pilothouse.
- 7. Owners' suite is forward with large hull windows and central atrium.
- 8. Large crew quarters, separate from guest accommodations.
- 9. Single level, stepless access between owners' suite and main salon.
- 10. Guest ensuites for between three and five couples per owner's requirements.
- 11. Swimming pool on upper deck.
- 12. Open air flybridge for fair weather viewing.
