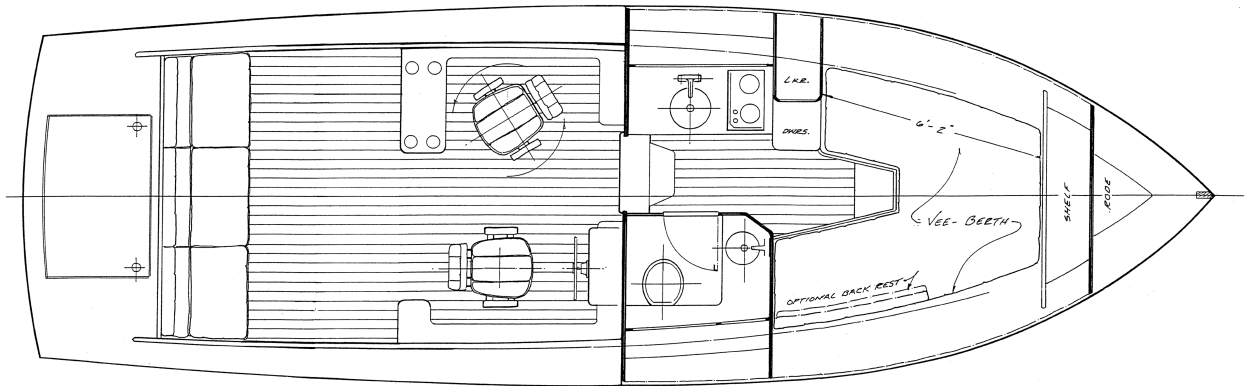

The French & Webb 32 is a classic Downeast day boat with a modern deep vee hull. Built of epoxy cold molded wood by French and Webb of Belfast, Maine, she is designed and equipped to the highest standard. She has a large cockpit with laid teak decking, good shelter beneath a hardtop, and a charming interior with just enough headroom for owners of modest stature to enjoy a weekend cruise on Penobscot Bay. There's even a fully enclosed head.



The single stern drive is powerful enough to drive her at 28 knots, and the cold molded wood hull is strong, stiff and has excellent sound deadening qualities. Access to the engine is through a large counterbalanced hatch in the stern deck.
