Brierley & Associates also of Camden, she is truly a magnificent yacht, the largest aluminum sailing yacht ever built in the United States at the time of her launching. Her 7,000 square foot sail plan is entirely roller-stowing and all winches are captive, making her sail handling far safer than the majority of large yachts.
